

**RESOLUTION  
TO ALLOW RED CLAY CONSOLIDATED SCHOOL DISTRICT TO MANAGE OUR CABLE  
ACCESS EDUCATIONAL CHANNEL FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING EDUCATIONAL  
PROGRAMMING TO RESIDENTS WITHIN NEW CASTLE COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Newport has a franchise agreement with Comcast Cable. As part of that agreement, the town has the opportunity to utilize three public access channels, all of which are dormant. One of those channels must be used for educational purposes, and

**WHEREAS**, the Red Clay Consolidated School District is building a production studio in one of the district's high schools as part of the district's expanded career pathways and has requested that the town consider activating this channel and allowing them to be named manager of said channel to provide educational programming, sporting events, entertainment productions and other important happenings at Red Clay district schools. The process requires a letter to Comcast Cable requesting activation and naming Red Clay Consolidated School District as manager so the process of building this broadcast can begin, and

**WHEREAS**, this will benefit not only Newport residents but also our surrounding communities, be it


**RESOLVED**, that the Commissioners of the Town of Newport authorize the transfer of this educational channel for management by the Red Clay Consolidated School District for use, and be it




