There will be no Municipal Election for 2025. There were three open seats on Council and there were three candidate intention forms received.

Stephanie Banks, Michael Capriglione and Michele MacDonald will be sworn in on Thursday, April 17, 2025, at 6:45 pm, prior to the Regular Meeting of the Mayor and Council.

Spring Cleanup Day will be Saturday, April 19, 2025. Waste Management will be around to collect your unwanted household items. For safety reasons, mattresses need to be wrapped. The normal exclusions apply – no paints, household hazardous waste, yard waste, construction debris, or old refrigerators/AC units. Please call Wendy if you have any questions.

The long-awaited construction project on E. Ayre Street from S. Augustine to S. James Street will begin in early April. The street will be milled, and new asphalt will be laid. Two concrete swales will be poured. Curbing at the corners will be ADA-compliant. The contractor, DePaul and Company, will be sending a notice to the residences and businesses in the area of the job describing the scope of work and will be providing contact information for you in case you have any questions or concerns as the job is progressing. It is anticipated that the project will take 60 calendar days. The town's website will be updated with a page dedicated to the project with contact information and a PDF document of the plans.
